



## MAP Policy Changes on MAP Mass

### Changes to the RIA Course

As a reminder, the Department of Public Health (DPH) Medication Administration Program (MAP) released an updated MAP Policy Manual on November 17, 2025. [A summary of the November 2025 MAP Policy Updates is here.](#)

The **'Responsibilities in Action' (RIA)** course on MapMass was updated to reflect these policy changes, and the new version of the course opened to students on December 4, 2025. Students who enrolled **before December 4, 2025** are completing their course work in the old version of the course. As a reminder, the old course will close on **February 1st, 2026**. Any student who has not finished by that date must enroll in the new course. To do this, please submit these students on an upcoming course roster.

Students enrolled on or after December 4th, 2025 will continue normally in the new version of the course and will be archived after 4 months, as required by MAP policy.
