

## **Maintaining MAP Trainer Status**

The MAP Policy Manual was recently updated and is posted at the mass.gov/dph/map website or click <a href="here">here</a> to view. Policy 04-1 'MAP Trainer Requirements'.

All MAP Trainers, *including those who previously only conducted MAP recertifications*, are required to do the following in order to maintain 'Approved MAP' Trainer status:

- be knowledgeable of all current DPH MAP Regulations, Policies and Advisories;
- remain current by viewing mandatory webinars during the required timeframe to receive credit, attending mandatory meetings; and
- conduct at least one (1) MAP Certification Training per year using the DPH approved MAP Curriculum and Required Components.
  - MAP Trainers may co-train a full MAP Certification Training provided that all Trainers actively participate in the training.

## WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

- Trainers will need to come into compliance with the new policy on maintaining current MAP Trainer status by *December 31, 2023*.
- As of January 1, 2024, if a MAP Trainer has not conducted one MAP Certification class between January 1, 2023, and December 31, 2023, or did not view the following (4) webinars in the required time, their access to TMU will be 'turned off'.
  - 2022 Summer Webinar (posted July 2022)
  - 2023 Winter Webinar (posted January 2023)
  - MAP Training and Testing Updates Webinar (posted February 2023)
  - 2023 Summer Webinar (posted August 2023, required to be viewed before October 18, 2023 to receive credit)
- A MAP Trainer who had their TMU access turned off will need to register and complete the online MAP Train the Trainer course

before they can become reinstated as a MAP Trainer.
